THE KALEIDOSCOPE TOUR:
EXPLORING THE MANY COLORS AND IMAGES OF THESSALONIKI

Thessaloniki's long history and troubled past are reflected in today's urban landscape as a kaleidoscope of colours and images of different ethnic groups and the cultural production of the communities that have lived in this major Balkan port through the centuries. On this tour the city's monuments become the reference points for understanding its different historical periods and introducing its ethnic communities of the past: Roman (Galerius Complex, Rotunda, Roman Forum), Byzantine (examples of 4th-15th century churches listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites), Ottoman (examples of mosques, hamams, markets), Jewish (Yad Lezikaron Synagogue & Holocaust monument). City landmarks will mark the beginning and end of this overview of Thessaloniki's multicultural identity, from the Byzantine Walls and the city's panoramic view, to the White Tower, the city's monument emblem, to the port, the focal point for the city's occupation history and population movement.
